

Responsibilities of a Councilor -

- Each [Division](#) elects a male and female councilor to represent the bowlers of their region to Bowls USA. A councilor is considered a division officer and is selected during annual elections.
- A councilor's primary job is communication between their division and Bowls USA, being sure the interests of their division are clearly expressed. A councilor votes on national issues as he/she is directed by their division.
- Councilors participate in national committees looking for ways to grow and improve Bowls USA at the club, division, and national levels.
- Councilors attend meetings of Bowls USA annually in person at the Associations General Meeting prior to the US Open and bi-monthly through online forums.

Get Involved -

To become a division councilor you should attend Division meetings to learn about the various clubs in the region. Get involved in your Division's activities and find out what is important to the bowlers in your area. Lastly make your division officers aware that you are interested in representing your division and would like to be considered a candidate for the position at the next election.
