The National Council approved a President's Award for the purpose of:

PURPOSE

- Recognizing outstanding service in the promotion and support of the sport of lawn bowls within the Bowls USA organization
- Recognizing outstanding work in the endeavor of a specific project assigned by the President and/or the National Council
- Recognizing long and distinguished service to Bowls USA

PROCESS

This recognition may be awarded by the President of Bowls USA as recommended by any creditable source and with the consultation and approval of the Executive Board

- Nominations for a President's Award must be made in writing to the National Secretary at least 30 days prior to the Annual General Meeting.
- Nominations must include a resume justifying the basis for the award.
- Nominations must be for a living member of Bowls USA.

TYPES OF AWARDS

The President's Award may include, but is not limited to, the following:

- Certificates of Service or Achievement
- Inscribed plaques, medals, paperweights, etc.
- Lifetime membership in Bowls USA
- Bowling apparel, bowls, or accessories
- The President's Award may not be in the form of cash

NOTIFICATION

- The President's Award will be presented at the Annual General Meeting.
 - If the recipient is not in attendance, then the National Secretary will notify the recipient's Division President of the award.
- The award will be forwarded to the Councilor(s) of the recipient's Division, and the Councilor(s) will make arrangement to present the President's Award at the recipient's home club or division with the participation of the Division's President
- The National Secretary will provide sufficient detail for publication on the Bowls USA website and newsletter.
